Certified in Dental Infection Prevention and Control® (CDIPC®) Certification

Requirements

There are education and experience requirements to apply for the CDIPC exam. This is the main pathway to earn CDIPC certification, with several education and experience options available.

EDUCATION

Complete one of the following options.

Pass DANB's ICE exam within the last 5 years or currently hold CDA, COA, NELDA, or DISIPC certification	Complete steps one and two. EXPERIENCE

Complete at least 1,040 hours of work experience as a dental assistant, hygienist, dentist, office manager, educator, consultant, trainer, or dental inspector/investigator.
