Requirements

There are education and experience requirements to apply for the DISIPC exam. This is the main pathway to earn DISIPC certification, with several education and experience options available.

EDUCATION

Complete steps one and two. You only need to select one option from step two.

2. Complete **one** of the education options:

Complete at least 1,040 hours of work experience as a dental practice manager, dental sales professional, or dental inspector/investigator
